**Job Description**

**Role:** The Jetter Vac Operator will safely conduct all daily tasks/duties associated the safe operation of the Vac Con Truck. Will operate Vac Con jet trucks in the cleaning and inspection of storm drains.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Checks and maintains safe and efficient operations of Vac Con truck and related equipment including air compressors, water pumps, fuel pumps, air-conditioning equipment blowers, and automatic emergency lighting.
- Monitors gauges and computer printout of machine performance; tends oiler controls and gauges; adjusts or repairs broken or worn parts. Periodically cleans and overhauls equipment. Sets and adjusts controls to achieve desired performance.
- Lubricates equipment and changes oil and filters.
- Checks, repairs, or replaces valves and controls to maintain proper operation of equipment.
- Load and discharges liquids and semi solids as required.
- Checks and adjusts emission control equipment and recorders.
- Maintains required company records. Sets up, checks, and replaces recording charts and tapes. Maintains log operations by shift.
- Supervises laborers during semiannual PM's.
- Keeps equipment clean and orderly.
- Notifies supervisor of any potentially dangerous equipment, practices, or violations of safety.
